



DISASTER DONATION GUIDE

When a major catastrophic event occurs, it is usually followed by a gracious outpouring of love, support, and donations — all of which are essential in the recovery process. Whether hurricane, flood, fire, tornado, or something else, the support of surrounding communities is crucial.



The greatest need in disasters is always cash donations. This allows responders to immediately meet the specific needs of disaster survivors without incurring many of the costs associated with sorting, packing, transporting, and distributing goods.



If you would like to donate items, call your local Salvation Army to determine what the greatest need is. While clothing is considered vital to the Salvation Army Family Store, it is typically not needed during disasters.



Consider donating cleaning supplies, water, non-perishable food, diapers, and care packages instead. Care packages include shampoo, conditioner, soap, a cloth rag, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, etc. We ask that care packages come sorted by gender and age to aid in quick distribution.



The Salvation Army disaster services are funded entirely by donation, and we use 100% of all disaster donations in support of disaster relief operations.

The Salvation Army works closely with federal, state, and local authorities to assist in responding to natural and man-made disasters. Our disaster teams are ready to jump into action at a moment's notice to offer food, shelter, and other necessities such as emotional and physical support. However, we can not do this alone.
