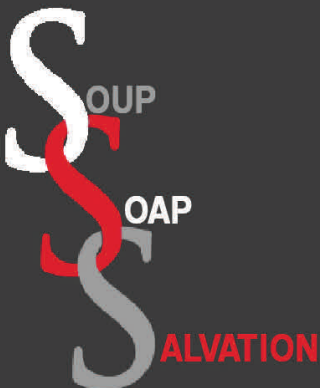

TEAM INFORMATION

STEPS TO RESERVE A TEAM RESTORATION PROJECT

1. DESIGNATE A PRIMARY TEAM MEMBER CONTACT

Choose an individual for your team which TSA can contact with any questions.

2. COMPLETE AND RETURN THE TEAM REQUEST FORM

We suggest that you schedule your team build 1-2 months in advance to guarantee your requested day or days

3. CONFIRMATION

Remember that the date you requested is not reserved until you receive confirmation from TSA

4. PAYMENT

We ask that payment is received at least 2 weeks prior to your renovation project date. This will guarantee all supplies will be on hand for your employees

5. HELP RESTORE IT!

Arrive to the **Center of Hope** on time, prepared for a rewarding and fun day!

TEAM CONTACT RESPONSIBILITIES

RECRUIT GROUP MEMBERS

Groups are limited to a maximum of 25 people. Please note that we cannot accept larger groups, though you may consider scheduling an additional group slot if you have more than 25 volunteers for one day.

COORDINATE ON SITE ARRIVAL

Everyone must arrive in the lobby at **The Center of Hope** by 8:30 am, for a brief safety orientation and designated duty assignment. Lunch will be served around 11:30am and the build day ends at 3:00pm.

INFORM VOLUNTEERS

Make sure all volunteers in the group have the information needed to make the day a success. It is important to familiarize yourself with the Salvation Army Volunteer guidelines in order to inform your group of relevant information like site restrictions, appropriate clothing, etc.

PROJECT VOLUNTEER FAQ'S

How long are we expected to volunteer/can I come for part of the day?

Volunteers are expected to be on-site at 8:30 a.m. All volunteers are asked to stay for the entire day. Plan on staying until about 3:00 p.m.

Do I need construction experience to volunteer with The Salvation Army?

No! All skill levels are welcome to volunteer with us! If you are skilled please help those around you. Trained staff and volunteers will help you along the way. Please note that physical work is a task and you should be comfortable being on your feet for extended periods of time.

What about Lunch?

Lunch takes place around 11:30 a.m. Corporate Team's will be provided with lunch by TSA. We ask that you don't leave the **Center of Hope** during your scheduled day. Feel free to have food delivered to the site. If you choose not to utilize TSA provided lunch. Please let your coordinator know your lunch plans prior to arrival.

What should I wear?

Please remember that ALL volunteers must wear closed toed shoes and LONG pants. No flip flops. Sneakers or boots are best. Wear comfortable clothing that isn't too baggy or revealing.

Do I need to bring my own tools?

Volunteers are not required to bring their own tools. We recommend that you bring work gloves if you have a pair. Please note all volunteers are required to use the appropriate safety equipment as instructed by TSA staff.

What will I do as a Center of Hope volunteer?

Volunteers will work on the building needs as determined by The Salvation Army staff. Please remember that we ask you come with a willingness to try new things and an open mind.

How do I volunteer and can I volunteer more than once?

All volunteers MUST pre-register with the volunteer coordinator prior to arrival. Yes, you can come more than once! If you are interested in volunteering on a reoccurring basis you should talk to the volunteer coordinator for more information.

Where is the project site located?

The Salvation Army, Center of hope is located at 110 Presto Lane, Jackson 39206.

Volunteers will be asked to park directly in front of the Center and wait for your crew member to open the doors.

What else should I know?

Bring a water bottle. We'll have water available for you to drink on-site. Remember to drink plenty of water before, during, and after your build. Smoking is allowed in designated smoking areas only. Refrain from bringing any electronic devices to the Center with you. We recommend leaving these items at home or in your car for the duration of the day. Before you begin, you must have a valid waiver on file to volunteer with TSA.

The volunteer coordinator will be your contact for the waivers prior to arrival. If you have not signed a waiver, you may fill one out on site.

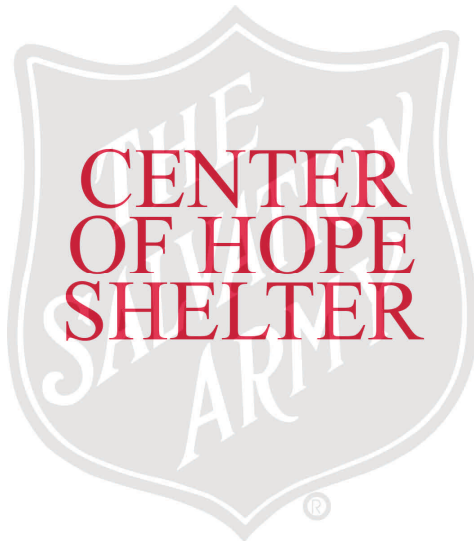
