RED KETTLES ACROSS THE MS GULF COAST BRING IN \$41,444.87 IN FIRST SIX DAYS

Still have \$283,555.13 to reach goal

Gulfport, MS (November 26, 2012) Every penny has been counted from the first six days of Red Kettle operations across the Mississippi Gulf Coast and so far \$41,444.87 has been raised for the life changing programs that The Salvation Army MS Gulf Coast operates every day of the year.

The total goal for The Salvation Army MS Gulf Coast Area Command is \$325,000. This goal is broken down into two parts between Jackson County and Harrison County. To date, Jackson County has raised \$19,731.25 of its \$125,000 goal and Harrison County has raised \$21,713.52 of its \$200,000 goal.

The Red Kettle Campaign is the largest fundraising time of the year for The Salvation Army and relies heavily on volunteers donating their time. The funds raised from the Red Kettle Campaign go to the operational costs of the traditional social services that The Salvation Army provides throughout the entire year such as food pantries, utility assistance, emergency shelter and so much more.
